'Swayampurna Goa' Initiative Going Great Guns

“Swayampurna Goa Program is one of the key agendas of our government. It aims to empower every Goan residing in the village panchayats and municipalities to become self reliant”.

- Dr. Pramod Sawant, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Goa

Swayampurna Goa Program has been launched by the Hon CM of Goa, Dr Pramod Sawant and monitored by the Directorate of Planning, Statistics & Evaluation, Govt of Goa. In the ambitious Swayampurna Goa initiative, govt. will focus on increasing economic activity within the state and reduce dependence on neighbouring states like Karnataka & Maharashtra. The major objective is to ensure that every village in the state becomes self-reliant (swayampurna) by harnessing resources available within the area, by making the best use of state and central government schemes and grants and also by involving NGOs and social welfare organisations, wherever required.

Swayampurna Goa Program 2020-21

The Swayampurna Goa Program was launched on 2nd October 2020 amidst the COVID pandemic. In this initiative, benefits of all the state and central government schemes are being taken literally to the doorstep of people. As a part of the Swayampurna Goa initiative, government officers designated as Swayampurna Mitras and village panchayat secretaries are reaching out to each and every needy in the village panchayat and municipalities. This will ensure that every individual in the nook and corner of Goa becomes self-reliant by harnessing the available resources within the local area.

Swayampurna Goa Initiative will be implemented in three phases of one year each as shown in the table below:-



Involvement of Swayampurna Mitra

The government officers, designated as “Swayampurna Mitra”, appointed for each of the 191 village panchayats and 14 municipalities dedicate their non working day of Saturday to visit their respective assigned village panchayat and municipality. These Swayampurna Mitras (SMs) provide benefits of all the state and central government schemes to the eligible beneficiaries through the Link Officers (LO) of different departments. Under the program, in future, the government will also undertake skill mapping of the population and resource identification of villages to ensure that every village becomes self-sustainable.

The state govt. wants to achieve all the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), eradicate poverty and dependence on other states by every village through the Swayampurna Goa Initiative. It is possible through the participation of locals along with the state government. The program will be banking on data collected by the Swayampurna Sahayaks (SS) appointed at each ward level, plus data from various other government sources and agencies about the eligible needy people, social and economic assets and liabilities of each village.

CM Dr Pramod Sawant said, in the next phases of the program, self employment, entrepreneurship and startups will also be encouraged under Swayampurna Goa initiative by facilitating ease of doing business, mentorship, funding etc. As a part of Swayampurna Goa, training and skill upgradation programs would be conducted during the entire year for people to enhance their skills and employability.

The state of Goa, off late has been relying on importing food and related goods from other states because the traditional farming and fishing communities have moved to more lucrative occupations that have flourished due

to the tourism and mining industry. Despite some of the best subsidies offered for farming and agriculture activities in Goa, every day, the state procures nearly 2 lakh litres of milk from outside the state, tonnes of vegetables and fruits, chicken, mutton and around 1.5 lakh eggs, especially during the peak tourist season in Goa. The objective of Swayampurna Goa program is to eventually substitute these imports through local produce.

The Hon Chief Minister Dr Pramod Sawant is personally monitoring the progress of the initiative through virtual interactions with the panchayats and also through personal visits in different villages. Recently in one such interaction he urged all government officers to be Karmayogis in their efforts to conduct the exercise to make Goa Swayampurna especially this year, being the year of India's 75th year of independence and Goa completing 60 years of its Liberation from the Portuguese rule.

Achievements of best performing panchayats, Swayampurna Mitras to be lauded

Stressing on the self sustainability aspect of the state by citing examples, CM, Dr Pramod Sawant has said that Goa is slowly and steadily moving towards becoming self-sufficient, duly assisted by government staff and also with the help of private establishments, social welfare groups and associations.

The Chief Minister recently addressed the newly appointed Swayampurna Mitras and Swayampurna Paryavekshaks (SP), who largely are senior level IAS officers who are supervising the program, at an orientation training programme held at seminar hall, at the Secretariat, Porvorim Goa.

- ▶ People of the village identified alternate land for farming and harvested tomatoes, chillies, cucumbers, brinjals etc as some fields were flooded due to the Tillari canal. The matter is taken up with WRD for solution.
- ▶ 30 homeless people without identity cards were administered a vaccine in the Assnora shelter home as they were old and infirm and could not travel to the vaccination centre.
- ▶ 70 coconut saplings in association with Agriculture Dept and 250 saplings of fruit bearing trees were distributed in association with Forest Dept.
- ▶ 33 senior citizen cards distributed.
- ▶ UDID 18 cards are in the process.
- ▶ 85 benefited with medical equipment donation.
- ▶ 38 Toilets.
- ▶ 17 Water Connection.
- ▶ 19 Electricity Connection.
- ▶ 3 House construction licenses issued in Panchayat jurisdiction.

Major Achievements

- ▶ Community hall project under 'Adivasi Vikas Yojana' of Goa Tribal welfare Department. Project Architect of Tribal Department from Pune, Maharashtra visited the site and did the estimates.
- ▶ Proposal moved to construct a bandhara in village Bandoli through WRD .
- ▶ Solved canal water issue in Karmane: Called joint meeting of villagers and WRD officers to discuss and plan release of water on time sharing pattern. Proposal of installing a new pump is moved by the WRD.
- ▶ Eco-Tourism Project: Four youth in Rumbrem and Bandoli have taken property on lease to start a concept of tribal village life. The self-help group in a village will prepare food for the tourists. Local ayurvedic medicines and treatment will be given to the tourist. Organic farming will be done at the site and organic products will be sold to the tourists. This project will make at least 15 families in the village swayampurna. The 1st batch of tourists visited the eco tourism site and youth and SHG earned RS. 9,000/- in the month of August 2021.
- ▶ Proposed panchayat market in private property to provide fixed place for selling organic products of self-help group members at Savorgal Codli in a private plot of 10,000 sq mtrs. The proposal has been submitted to the panchayat for resolution and NOC.
- ▶ Chaturthi Bazar cum department Camp organised in association with Tribal Welfare Department. In this camp 111 applications were processed for Udyog Aadhar Scheme and various competitions were also organised.
- ▶ 6 applicants completed training in Bee-keeping and Bee Boxes will be handed over shortly.
- ▶ 29 Krishi Cards for Agriculture farmers.
- ▶ 6 Krishi Cards and 3 Kisan Credit Cards for Dairy Farmers.
- ▶ 5 Senior Citizen Cards.
- ▶ 4 PWD (Divyang) benefited.
- ▶ Proposed community hall in village Bandoli under Goa Gram Samrudhi Yojana (GGSY) of RDA Department. Engineer has inspected the site for an estimate.

It is a clarion call given by the Chief Minister during the COVID pandemic and often he has asserted that “We have to protect ourselves and move ahead as well”. The government has prepared an Action Plan for its 'Atmanirbhar Bharat, Swayampurna Goa' programme under the 'Economic Revival Plan for Village Panchayats' in the state, which was virtually launched on October 1, 2020.

The Chief Minister personally guided and held one-to-one interactions with the senior officers in order to make the mission successful. During the course of discussions, the Chief Minister reaffirmed the government's commitment to accomplish the goal of Swayampurna Goa on the lines of Atmanirbhar Bharat program and underlined his endeavour and vision to make this tiny state in the Indian Union, a 'Bhangralem Goem'.

In pursuance to the call given by the **Prime Minister, Shri. Narendra Modi** to become '**Vocal for Local**' in elevating the living conditions of people under **Atmanirbhar Bharat** Mission, **Chief Minister, Dr Pramod Sawant** forthwith mooted the idea to make Goa self-reliant in all spheres of life under Swayampurna Goa program.

This was a much needed step considering that unless and until Goa became Swayampurna, we cannot accomplish the goal envisioned by the Prime Minister for Atmanirbhar Bharat and claim the self-sufficiency necessitated for revival of economy and taking Goa ahead.

Chief Minister, Dr Pramod Sawant who took reins of office after the demise of the former **Union Defence Minister and ex-Chief Minister of Goa, late Manohar Parrikar**, has been working ceaselessly to see that the government machinery is deployed wherever necessary and bring all the stakeholders to the fore for productive purposes, so that the goal of Swayampurna Goa is achieved.

“We will prosper and become successful only if we adhere to hard work, dedication and determination,” the Chief Minister emphasizes.

Atmanirbhar Bharat is a vision of **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** in making India one of the most prosperous nation in Asia only next to China, which has emerged as a leading country across the globe. The efforts initiated by the **Chief Minister, Dr Pramod Sawant** to make Goa self-reliant has infused enthusiasm among all sections of the society to supplement the efforts of the government to achieve the desired goal.

Under the '**Swayampurna Goa**' program, a study for the economic revival of village panchayats was undertaken by the **Directorate of Higher Education and GIPARD**. Altogether, 25 colleges were involved in the data collection, analysis and report preparation of all the 191 panchayats and 14 municipalities in the state. The core team consisting of the officers of DHE, GIPARD and colleges were constituted to prepare the action plan.

In the first phase of the Swayampurna Goa program, the aim is to achieve 100% results on the following 10 goals:

1. Tap Water Connection for all houses
2. Electricity connection for all houses
3. Shelter (house) for all
4. Sanitation (Toilet) for all houses
5. Krishi Card, PM Kisan, Kisan Credit Card & Soil Health Card for all eligible
6. Aid for all Divyangs (disabled)
7. Health Security - Deen Dayal Swasthya Seva Yojana to all eligible persons.
8. Social Security - Griha Adhar for Women & Dayanand Samajik Suraksha to all eligible persons.
9. Financial security - Bank Account, PM Jeevan Jyoti Bima (Rs. 2 lakhs life insurance @Rs. 330 per year premium) & PM Suraksha Bima Yojana (Rs. 2 lakhs life insurance on accidental death @Rs. 12 per year premium) to all eligible persons.
10. Aid to Senior Citizens through Senior Citizen Card.

The Chief Minister is personally monitoring the program and constantly interacting with government officials, who are integral to this concept. Various orientation-cum-training sessions are being held throughout the year. The training programmes are aimed at sensitising the participants on topics related to Swayampurna Goa, **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**, Atmanirbhar Bharat, finance management, accounting systems, centrally sponsored schemes and the vision document of the Govt departments.

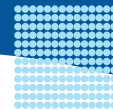
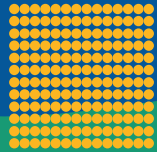
The Chief Minister endeavours to take the administration to the doorstep of the people. He says that the government officers, besides sitting in their office for discharging duties, need to also, get out of their offices to visit the field whenever required and conduct activities to attend to the people. Accordingly under the Swayampurna Goa Program, the state government has appointed 191 government officers as Swayampurna Mitras for as many village panchayats, 14 officers for municipalities and 12 Taluka Nodal Officers (TNO), one for each taluka. These Swayampurna Mitras are paying visits to the village panchayats even amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, so as to co-ordinate with the Sarpanch, panch members as well as village panchayat secretaries, for the implementation of the welfare projects and schemes under the state and the centre, and to see that the benefits of these schemes derived by the needy and deserving people. These officers in adherence to their role and responsibilities guide the representatives of the local self-government bodies in achieving sustainable development of the areas under the jurisdiction of the village panchayat ward they represent. The deliberations of Swayampurna Mitras with people and their local representatives will pave the way for rejuvenating the rural economy and improving the living conditions of the common man.

The Chief Minister has also directed his Cabinet Ministers and MLAs to visit village panchayats to get themselves acquainted with the problems being faced by the locals and to redress them.

The Chief Minister was of the opinion that the government departments should initiate efforts to ensure 100% implementation of the welfare schemes to accomplish the goal of '**Aatmanirbhar Bharat and Swayampurna Goa**'. The Swayampurna Goa campaign will undoubtedly help making Goa self-reliant and competitive. It will boost local manufacturing to convert the local products into global brands. People have been motivated tremendously, and have started availing benefits of Swayampurna Goa program. The days of success are not far, provided we stress on collective efforts to march ahead and be at the forefront to make Goa an ideal state.

Govt will ascertain data, activities by local self governance bodies under Swayampurna Goa: Sawant

Interacting with the local bodies and Swayampurna Mitras through virtual mode on one of the Saturdays, the Chief Minister said that the government will conduct third party surveys to ascertain data of villages, provided by local rural bodies and activities carried out by the Mitra and local self governance bodies under Swayampurna Goa initiative.



Chief Minister Pramod Sawant also said that the Hon Prime Minister Narendra Modi will interact with the beneficiaries of Swayampurna Goa program, village panchayat representatives of Goa through virtual mode on 'Atmanirbhar Bharat Swayampurna Goa' initiative in the near future.

He said that best Swayampurna Mitra award and best village panchayat and municipality awards will be given to the best performing local bodies under Swayampurna Goa initiative.

“On the basis of the assessment done by the third party agency, the village panchayats will be selected for awards in three categories viz. rural, urban and coastal panchayats,” he added.

The Chief Minister congratulated Swayampurna Mitras working in different village panchayats for taking extraordinary initiatives to make Goa self reliant.

“Many village panchayats have done commendable job under Swayampurna Goa mission by initiating various self employment generation programmes and enrolling beneficiaries under various government schemes. If we continue with this pace Goa would become self reliant in the near future,” he said.

Dr. Sawant appealed to the village panchayat bodies to take up projects worth Rs. 50 lakhs in their respective jurisdictions.

He also said that the municipal councils can take up a projects worth Rs. 1 crore in their respective jurisdictions under Swayampurna Goa initiative.



Govt eases process to avail benefits of schemes CM launches 'Know Your Schemes' service on Goa online portal

Chief Minister Pramod Sawant recently launched the 'Know your schemes' service on Goa Online Portal so that people can easily avail benefits of government schemes. Sawant said that with this initiative, the people will get information about the eligibility criteria for various schemes and information about online services of the government while sitting at home. **The Chief Minister** stated that the people will not need to go to the offices in Panaji to submit applications for availing schemes as many departments have online uploading system of applications and required documents. The Chief Minister said as of now, twenty departments have uploaded information relating to 190 public-oriented schemes and added that in future all government schemes will be made available through portal.

With 'Know Your Schemes' service, citizens will be able to identify all the related schemes based on their personal, demographic, socio-economic, education, sector-wise information on a single portal. The system will auto assess the citizens' requirements, map the same and list out the related schemes departmentwise that can be availed, the Chief Minister added. He urged the people to approach the respective panchayat in case of any difficulty and also directed the panchayats to assist all such people so that the benefits of the related schemes reach all the deserving persons.

The '**Know Your Schemes**' service is developed by Goa Electronics Ltd under e-district programme. Dr. Sawant said the initiative is taken by the government through department of Information Technology in coordination with directorate of Planning, Statistics and Evaluation. Sawant launched the programme through virtual mode at a function in the presence of the principal secretary Finance Puneet Kumar Goel, director of information technology Ankita Anand and other officials. The Chief Minister said that many citizens are not aware of the various benefits provided by the government adding, “**This service is an endeavor of the government to provide information of all beneficiary-oriented schemes at the doorstep so that the fruits can reach everyone.**”
